## ANWB Camping inspections

For decades, Dutch campers have relied on the ANWB when it comes to advice and information about campsites. Every year, our independent campsite inspectors travel across Europe to assess some 2,000 campsites for those aspects that are considered most important by Dutch campers.

### Score with your campsite

The final score is expressed in stars, with 5 stars as the highest achievable score. If your campsite has achieved the highest score, it will be awarded the designation of ANWB Top Campsite, and for 3 or more stars, it will carry the label of ANWB-Certified Campsite. Other labels are Small Campsites and Charming Campsites. These two labels are not awarded based on the number of stars. A small campsite falls into this category when the campsite has a total of up to 60 pitches. A charming campsite is considered as such after a thorough investigation by the campsite inspector. This is a selection of campsites in beautiful and idyllic places in Europe, where personal attention from the campsite manager is of paramount importance, with an eye for hospitality.

### Classification of small campsites

In order to better serve the growing group of campers with a preference for small campsites, and to help small campsites to feature in the optimal manner in ANWB publications, we have recently launched a specific classification model for small campsites. This consists of those campsites that have a total of up to 60 pitches. When assessing these campsites, the campsite inspector will take into account aspects that are extra important for small campsites, such as privacy and extra large pitches. Also, aspects that are less relevant to small campsites will be awarded no or fewer points. This way, small campsites can also get the maximum score when compared with other small campsites. The new classification launched in 2021.

### Your inspection

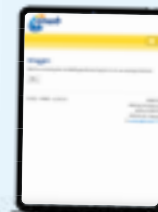
The aim is to inspect all campsites once every three to four years, because this way, the ANWB can ensure that the information for Dutch campers is up-to-date, and any improvements carried out at your campsite will come into their own within the star score. If you have realized important innovations, we would like to hear from you, as this may be a reason for us to visit your campsite at a sooner date.

### This is important for campers

- Sanitary facilities** 40%
